Sustainability Report 2025

Hotel Alexandre Teguisse Playa, at the initiative of its senior management, maintains the highest commitment to the protection of the global environment, as evidenced by the ongoing implementation of environmental certifications such as **Biosphere Sustainable Lifestyle, Travelife Gold**, and our membership in the Lanzarote Sustainable Accommodation Group (GAS), and by following the regulations and actions established and audited by specialist sustainability technicians:

Sustainability and Social Co-responsibility Policy:

- We comply with international, national and regional legislation; as well as other requirements.
- We maintain an EMS, which guarantees continuous improvement and provides a framework for establishing and reviewing the planned environmental objectives and the established goals.
- We involve all our stakeholders (shareholders, customers, employees, suppliers, subcontractors, and the local community) by engaging them in order to gain their recognition and support.
- Risk management will be a common practice in the organization focused on the treatment of risks associated with any of the adverse (threats) or beneficial environmental impacts and with the significant environmental impacts (opportunities). Wherever it is aware of the existence of a risk not covered by legislation, it will establish its own environmental standards and practices to adequately protect public health and the environment.
- We efficiently manage water and energy by guaranteeing the sustainable use of resources, mitigation and adaptation to climate change and the protection of biodiversity and ecosystems.
- We minimize the generation of waste by recycling, reducing and reusing products, enabling specific areas for them, so that everyone can recycle the waste they generate, as well as clean points to efficiently manage hazardous and special waste with training for staff and authorized managers.
- We prevent pollution through the identification, characterization and minimization of the negative environmental impact derived from rendering of services taking into account the life cycle approach, trying as far as possible, not to produce polluting emissions, and in the if they are unavoidable, measuring them to reduce them as much as possible.
- We select suppliers according to their commitment to the environment, and the reduction of carbon emissions caused by the transport of goods.
- We value the environment in which our establishments are located, from native species of flora and fauna to their local community, actively collaborating in their conservation and economic growth.
- We train staff and encourage the development of good environmental practices in their daily work.
- We keep updated this policy for its continuous adaptation to the purpose of the organization, the nature, magnitude and environmental impacts of its activities products and services guaranteeing its dissemination to stakeholders through all channels (our website, given information)

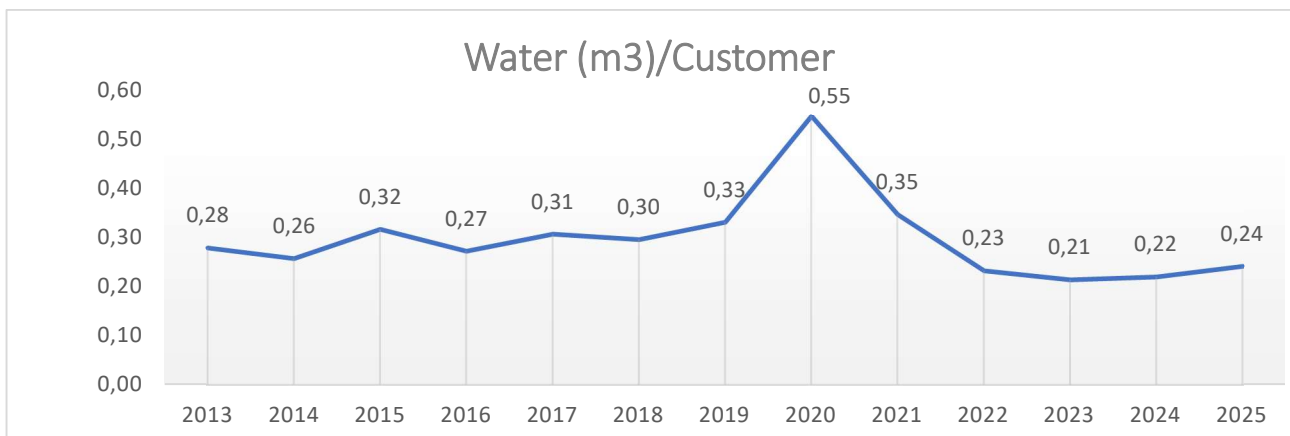
INDICADORES MEDIOAMBIENTALES

The environmental performance of **Alexandre Teguse Playa** has been quite significant since its inception. This is because the organization does not consume substantial natural resources, and the waste generated during its activities is managed either by companies authorized by the Government of the Canary Islands or by the municipal waste management service of the Teguse Town Hall, where the activities take place. There is clear evidence of the organization's compliance with waste management and consumption regulations.

Water:

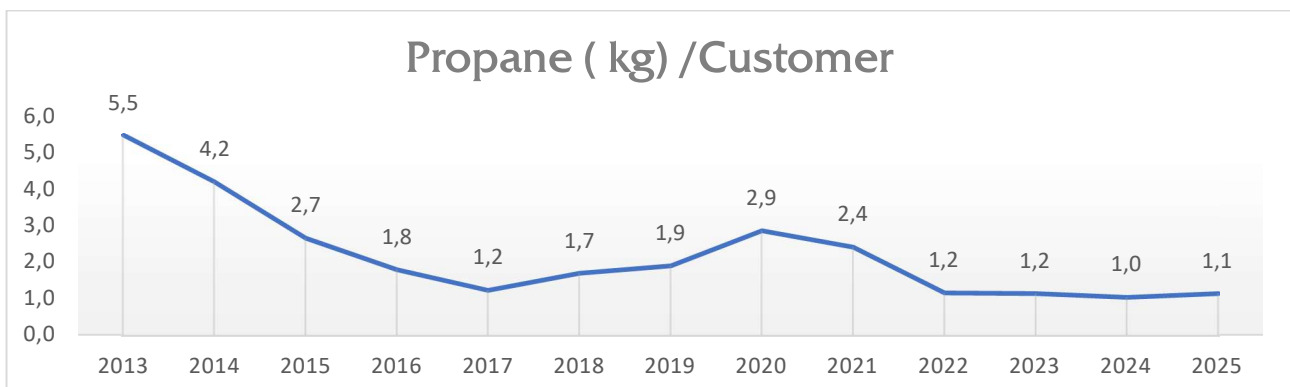
The replacement of bathtubs with showers following the comprehensive renovation carried out during the pandemic, along with a wide range of water control mechanisms installed, allows us to maintain water consumption rates at the lowest levels in recorded history.

The increase can be explained by the use of water produced by our desalination plant for bottles for internal consumption in our restaurant (km0 water).



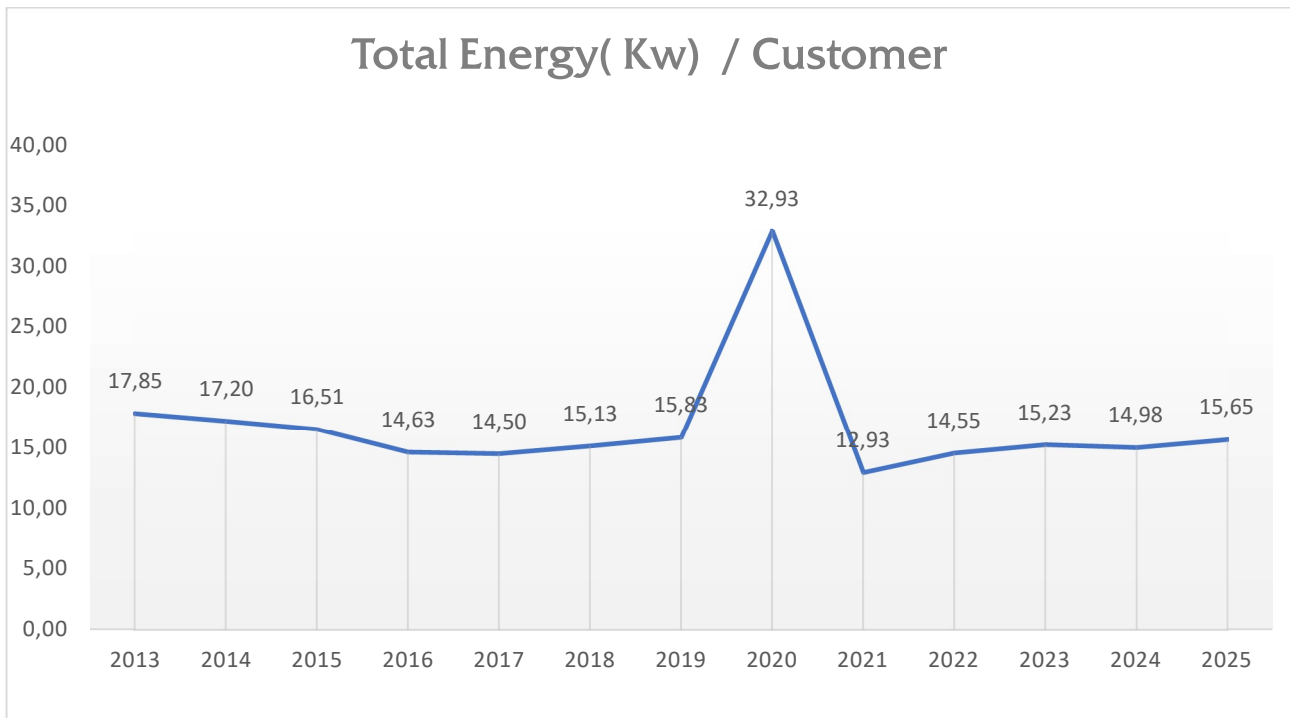
Propane:

The propane consumption/customer ratio increases slightly, although the historical series shows a high level of management of this resource, which has been brought to its operational minimums.



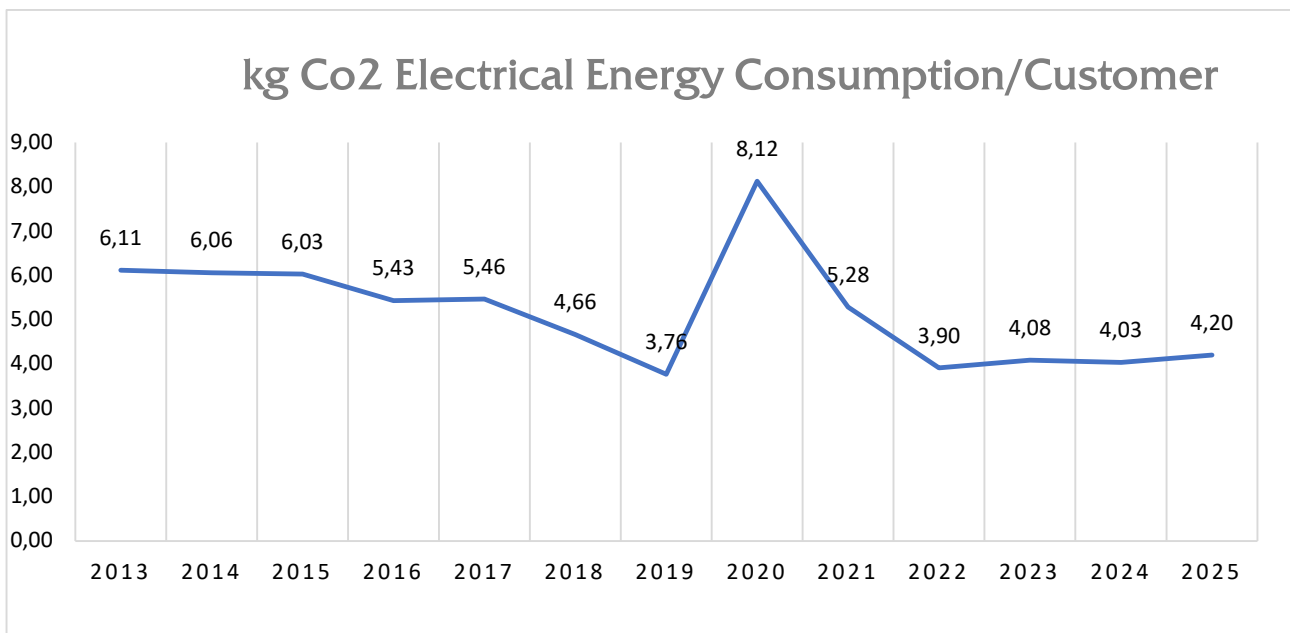
Electric power:

Thanks to the success in propane consumption, we have managed to keep the increases in the historical series under control and continue working towards this goal. Active lighting has seen an increase in the ratio that exceeds historical averages. The increasingly prolonged and intensive use of air conditioning due to climate change may explain this increase. We continue to work on alternative energy sources and invest in more energy-efficient machinery to help mitigate this increase.



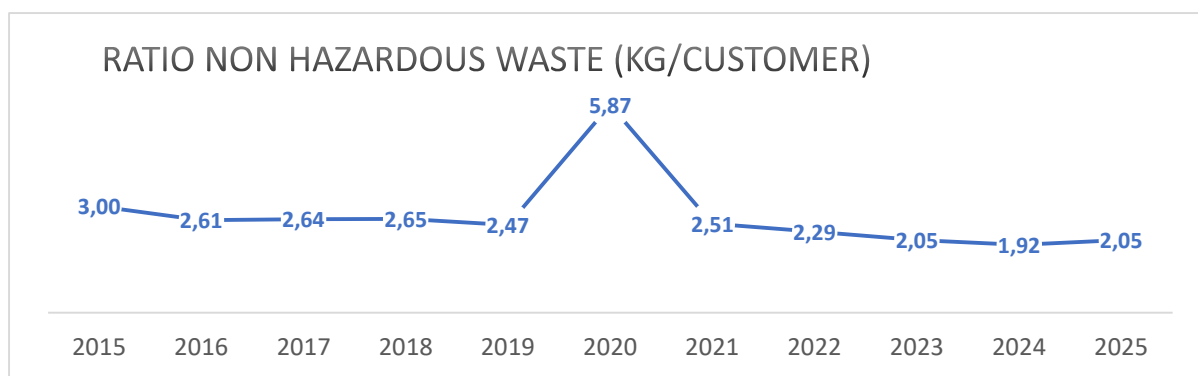
Carbon footprint:

We are keeping the increases below the historical average and continuing to work.



Waste:

Non-hazardous waste: Continuing our efforts to reduce waste, we have eliminated single-serving portions and improved techniques for food waste utilization and reducing quantities at the end of service to decrease organic waste. We also encourage bulk and volume purchases, reducing plastic use. The increase is minimal and due to adjustments in our central purchasing system.



It is important to note that waste is sorted and delivered for selective processing to authorized waste management companies designated by the Government of the Canary Islands, or it is managed by the Zonzamas Environmental Complex.

Organic waste is used for biogas production through bacterial fermentation.

Packaging from the yellow container is separated at the Zonzamas Environmental Complex's sorting plant into seven different materials (PET plastic, HDPE plastic, film plastic, mixed plastic, beverage cartons, ferrous cans, and aluminum cans), with over 90% of the packaging being recovered. All recovered and sorted materials are compacted and shipped for recycling in maritime containers off Lanzarote.

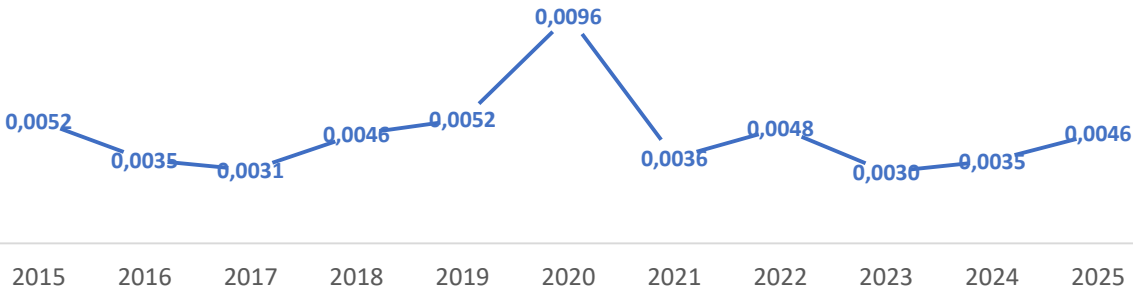
Currently, paper and cardboard are managed directly through the Martínez Cano plant in Arrecife. 100% of the paper and cardboard from the blue container is compacted, packaged, and shipped for recycling in maritime containers off Lanzarote.

Glass is managed in the dedicated glass area of the Zonzamas Environmental Complex, from where it is loaded into shipping containers and sent for recycling. 100% of the glass from the green recycling bins is sent for recycling outside of Lanzarote.

50% of the remaining waste is recovered at the Waste Sorting Plant, whose mission is to recover, separate, and classify mixed waste.

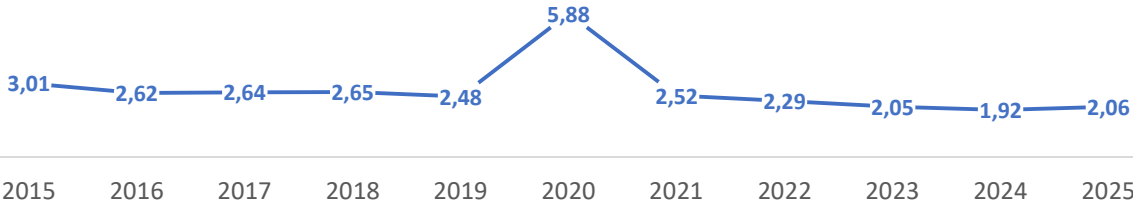
Hazardous waste: We continue to collect hazardous waste in accordance with regulations. The trend has been upward due to the replacement of obsolete equipment and maintenance work, as well as some adjustments to contracts with chemical suppliers, who are the main emitters of this waste.

Total waste volume: The total volume of waste is increasing due to the aforementioned causes. We are maintaining continuity in our purchasing management, applying environmental criteria to purchases, raising awareness among all stakeholders, and seeking solutions for recycling and reusing products.

SOCIAL CO-RESPONSIBILITY:

The management of the Alexandre Teguisse Playa Hotel has the objective of ensuring good relations between the establishment, the local community and its businesses, reducing the socioeconomic impacts and maximizing the well-being of the staff, as evidenced by our certifications of the Travelife Gold seal, ISO 14.001 and Biosphere, guarantees that we meet the sustainability criteria.

Promotion of Responsible Tourism in the area:

The Alexandre Teguisse Playa Hotel is committed to maintaining a close relationship with the local community, warning our clients about the importance of caring for and protecting the flora and fauna of the place, in addition to not participating in the sale of tickets to zoos or any other place in which the main attraction are the animals. Our hotel is committed to local commerce, and for this reason, local themed dinners are organized weekly in our Buffet to promote and publicize local food.

Purchasing policy:

The Alexandre Teguisse Playa Hotel promotes the purchase of locally produced products, ensuring that they comply with preventive health and safety measures, as well as the quality demanded by our customers. This fact helps to reduce CO2 emissions resulting from the transport of products produced outside the hotel's territory.

Employment:

The establishment recognizes the importance of hiring local staff as a preference, to collaborate the local economy. The policy preserves the destination, which is the basis for future clients and for those who repeat destination.

Donations and social collaborations:

Our hotel donates objects such as furniture and bedding that cannot be used more in business to local organizations that will be able to take advantage of them (Caritas, schools, hospitals, other NGOs ...). The Hotel actively collaborates with foundations for the benefit of children with serious illnesses and other groups at risk of exclusion, with local festivals and sporting and cultural events in the town.

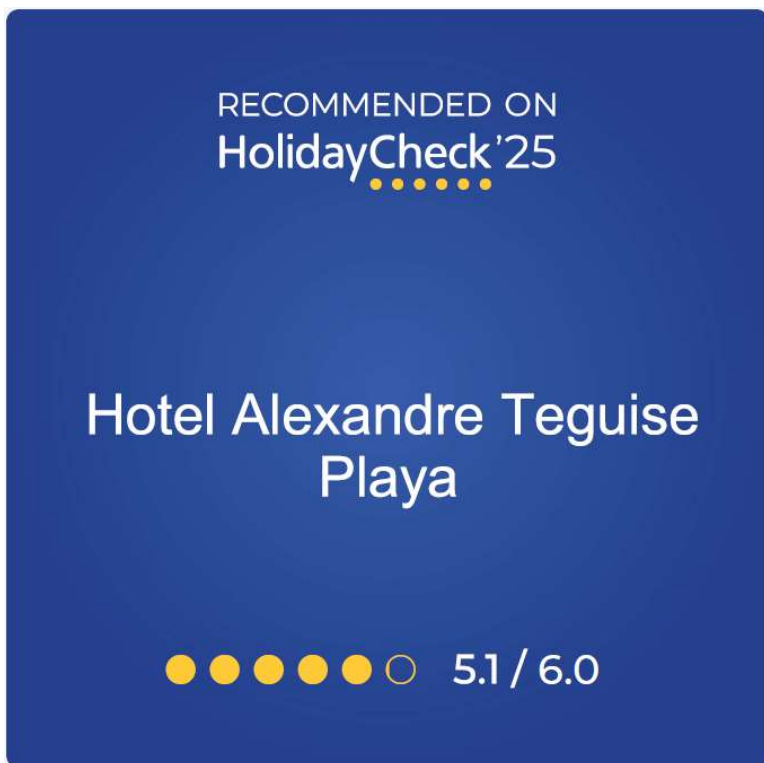
